

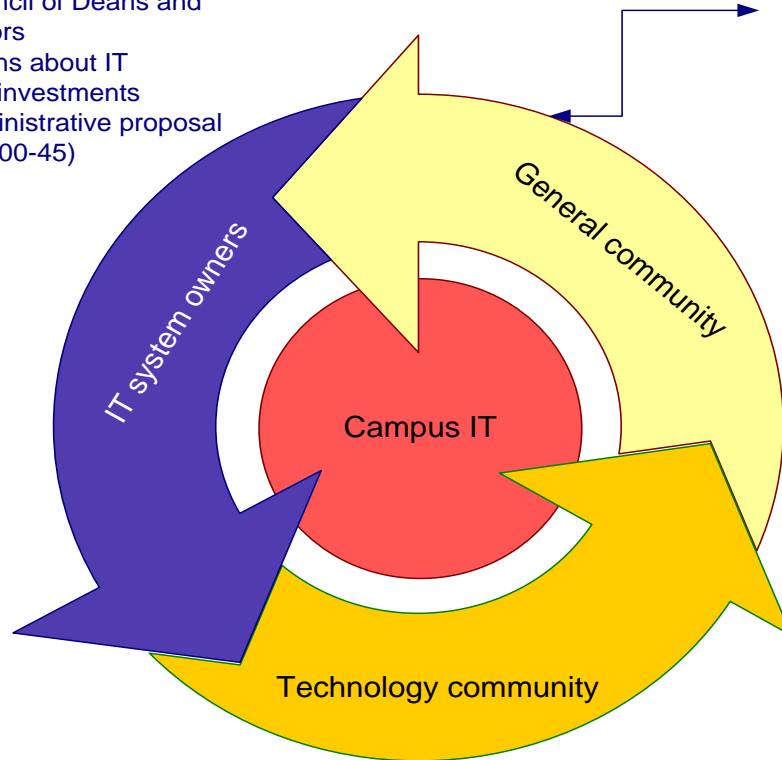
Campus IT Governance

Administrative IT Governance Board

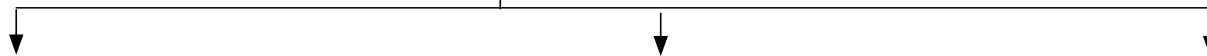
- Subset of Council of Deans and Vice Chancellors
- Makes decisions about IT administrative investments
- Oversees administrative proposal review (PPM 200-45)

Campus Council for Information Technology (CCFIT)

- ~30 members
- Advisory evaluation and review role
- Input from faculty, staff, students; faculty-driven
- Focus: significant IT-related plans and new IT intensive projects
- Small steering committee formulates position statements on IET priorities and campus IT plans
- Senate Committee on IT has formal representation on steering team and subcommittees



Academic Senate Committee on Information Technology (CIT)



Deans' Technology Council

- 10 members
- Official dean representatives; represent perspectives and needs of deans, academic units
- Focus: issues of importance and relevance to schools and colleges

Technology Infrastructure Forum

- ~40 campus units, academic & administrative; appointed by unit heads
- Identify and evaluate campus IT needs, projects, plans, initiatives
- Input: infrastructure, security, client support, policy, etc.

Technology Support Program

- Technology support staff in campus academic & admin units
- Day-to-day input to project sponsors, service providers
